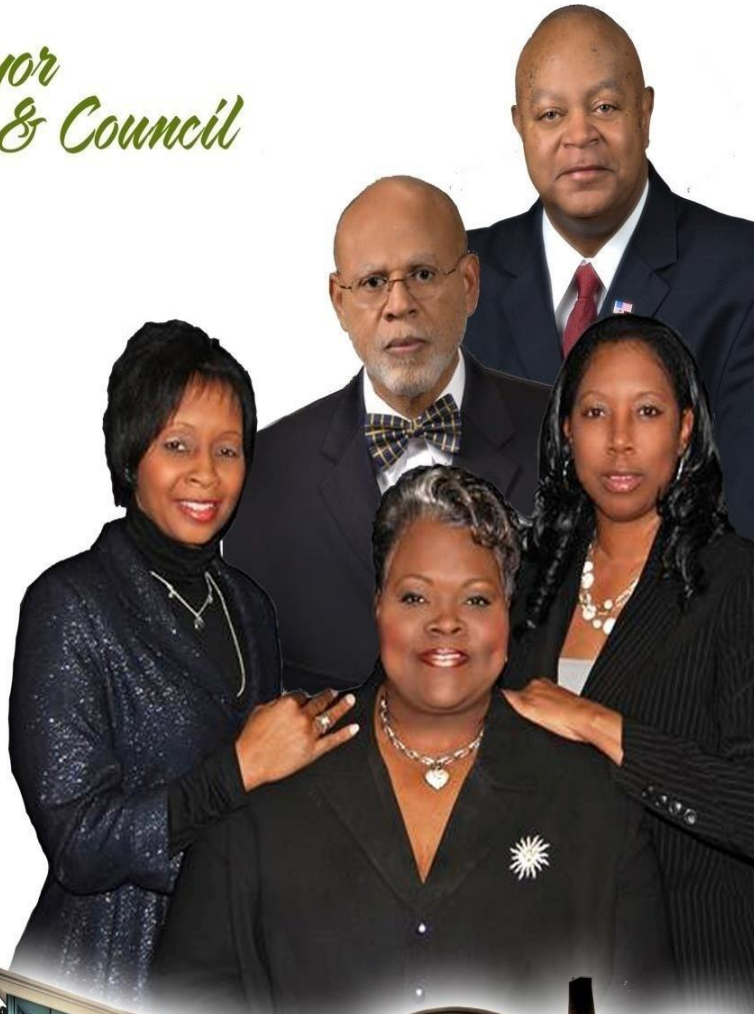

1. Rosa Vasquez, 7549 Coddington Ct, Riverdale, Georgia, 30274, spoke about her voting location and asked for assistance from the City regarding her concern.
2. Emma Godbee, 9775 Steeple Chase Lane, Riverdale Georgia, 30274, spoke about the lights in her subdivision and asked when they would be installed. She also spoke about the position of the Fire Marshall and the 911 Service.
3. Kimberly Stewart, 971 Steeple Chase Lane, Riverdale, Georgia, 30296, spoke about the Police and Fire Services and how to gain clarity about the Fire Ordinance. She also asked how to get the City's 911 Services returned to Riverdale.
4. Sterling Poole, 1012 Worth Court, Riverdale, Georgia, 30296, stated that he is a resident and a former member of the Riverdale Fire Department. Mr. Pool also spoke about the Fire Marshal position and commented that the position should not be given to Clayton County.
5. Jewel Lewis, 6995 Chimney Ridge, Riverdale, Georgia, 30296, spoke about the Fire Inspection Service. She stated that the residents should have a chance to decide whether the service should remain in the city.
