9. ADOPTION OF THE MINUTES: Meeting Minutes of May 14, 2018 Work Session and Business Session

Council Member Wallace made a motion to approve the May 14, 2018 Work and Business Session Minutes with Council Member Ruffin providing the second. **The motion carried unanimously.**

10. AGENDA ITEMS:

1) APPROVAL TO ADOPT THE FISCAL YEAR 2019 BUDGET / RESOLUTION NO. 27

Council Member Wallace made a motion to adopt the FY- 2019 Budget /Resolution No. 27 with Council Member Ruffin providing the second. **The motion carried unanimously.**

2) APPROVAL TO PURCHASE A VEEDER-ROOT AUTOMATIC TANK GAUGE MONITOR FOR INVENTORY CONTROL AND LEAK DETECTION / RESOLUTION NO. 28

Council Member Wallace made a motion to approve the purchase of a Veeder-Root Automatic Tank Gauge Monitor for inventory control and leak detection/Resolution No. 28 with Council Member Ruffin providing the second. **The motion carried unanimously.**

3) APPROVAL OF THE CITY MANAGERS EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT / RESOLUTION NO. 29

Council Member Wallace made a motion to approve the City Managers Employment Contract/Resolution No. 29 with Council Member Ruffin providing the second. **The motion passed with Council Members Wallace and Ruffin voting “Yes” and Council Members Stamps-Jones and Davis voting “No”. Council Member Wallace made a motion to approve the Personnel Policy Changes/Resolution No. 31 with one amendment; add from one day of bereavement to two days of bereavement for the Police Officers. Council Member Ruffin provided the second. **The motion carried unanimously.**
